

COOKIE POLICY

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. **Data Controller** – OASIS DIAGNOSTICS spółka akcyjna with its registered office in Konstancin Łódzki (ul. Langiewicza 54, 95-050 Konstancin Łódzki) entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for Łódź-Śródmieście in Łódź, XX Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000714713, National Business Registry Number (REGON): 369336270, Taxpayer Identification Number (NIP): 7312059969. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer: Konrad Cioczek, e-mail address: privacy@oasis-diagnostics.com
- 1.2. **Cookies** – IT data, small text files saved by the websites you visit and stored on the Device through which you use the Data Controller's Website. The information contained in cookies is necessary for the website to function properly, while these files are encrypted to prevent unauthorised access. The information collected in cookies can be read by the Data Controller and its contractors (for technical reasons)..
- 1.3. **Device** – an electronic device through which you access the Data Controller's Website.
- 1.4. **Website** – www.oasis-diagnostics.com including sub-pages.
- 1.5. **User** – any visitor to the Website.

2. USE OF COOKIES

- 2.1. The Data Controller uses Cookies via the Website.
- 2.2. Cookies are only used within the scope of the User's consent.
- 2.3. The information collected from Cookies is used for the proper optimisation of the Website, as well as for statistical and advertising purposes.
- 2.4. Cookies record the Website User's activity by recognising the Device, so that the Website is displayed in a way optimised to the individual User's preferences.
- 2.5. The solutions used on the Website are safe for the Devices of Users using the Data Controller's Website. It is not possible for dangerous or malicious software to enter User Devices.
- 2.6. The Data Controller uses two types of Cookies:
 - a) **Session cookies**: these are files that are stored on the User's Device and remain there until the User leaves the website or finishes shutting down the Internet browser. The stored information is then permanently deleted from the Device's memory. The mechanism of session Cookies does not allow any personal data or any confidential information to be collected from the User's Device;
 - b) **Persistent cookies**: these are stored on the User's Device and remain there until deleted. Files of this type remain on the User's Device for the time specified in the file parameters or until they are manually deleted by the User. Ending the session of a particular browser or switching off the Device does not remove them from the Device. The mechanism of persistent Cookies does not allow any personal data or any confidential information to be collected from the User's Device;
- 2.7. With regard to the source of the Cookies data, the Data Controller uses:
 - a) **First-party cookies**: files generated by the website and placed on it by the Data Controller (example: essential);
 - b) **Third-party cookies**: this is information originating from external servers, e.g. advertising, navigation providers (maps or search engines). These types of files allow for the evaluation of the effectiveness of advertising activities and the design of related activities according to the User's preferences (for example: analytical).
- 2.8. Cookies are divided according to their function on the Website:
 - **Basic cookies** – installed once the User has consented via the settings of the software installed on the device. Basic cookies include:
 - **Technical/essential cookies** – cookies which are essential for the proper functioning of the Website, including: for the correct display of the Website depending on the Device the User is using or the settings of that device; for the adaptation of content on the Website which is technically relevant for the

functioning of the Website (e.g. the language of the Website); for remembering whether the user has consented to the display of certain content;

- **Analytical cookies** – cookies used to measure the effectiveness of our marketing activities without identifying your personal data and to improve the functioning of our Website, including for the purpose of: researching statistics on Website traffic and verifying the source of traffic (so-called redirection directions); detecting misuse of Website traffic (e.g. artificial Internet traffic – bots); measuring the effectiveness of actions carried out on behalf of the Data Controller, e.g. in the Google advertising network, on external websites;

2.9. The User can delete cookies from the browser at any time and prevent them from being reinstalled.

3. WAYS OF DEFINING THE CONDITIONS FOR STORING OR ACCESSING COOKIES

3.1. The User has the option to restrict or disable access to Cookies on their Device. If this option is used, the use of the Data Controller's Website will be possible, except for functions that by their nature require Cookies.

3.2. The User may, independently and at any time, change their cookie settings, specifying the conditions for storing and accessing Cookies on the User's Device.

3.3. The User can change the settings referred to above via the settings of his/her browser or via the configuration of the service. These settings can be changed in particular so as to block the automatic handling of Cookies in the settings of your Internet browser or to inform you each time they are placed on your Device. Detailed information on the possibility and handling of cookies is available in the settings of your software (web browser). 3.4. The User can delete Cookies at any time using the available functions in the Internet browser they are using.

3.5. Restricting the use of Cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Data Controller's Website.
